

# Grade 7 Sample Lesson Plan: Stop it! Campaign to Stop Bullying-Summative Lesson

#### SOLs

Explain how bullying and harassment affects health and safety. Create a campaign to prevent bullying in school and online.

#### **Objectives/Goals**

- The student will explain how bullying and harassment affect health and safety.
- The student will create a campaign to cope with and prevent bullying in school and online.

#### Procedure

Lesson opening

- Review lesson 9 Formative
- Effects of bullying
- What to do/not to do about bullying

During the lesson

- Stop it! Campaign to stop bullying.
  - Using a variety of self-designed templates or those included below (L9.4-9.7S). Write the title: What to do about bullying.
  - Using the What to do when being bullied statements (L9.1S), and the effects of bullying (L9.2S) select one bullying statement and one effect of bullying and write them on the template. Be creative! Decorate and place throughout the school in an effort to help

victims cope with a bully in a healthy way.

• Formative assessment: Students place the red rectangle on top if they do not know what to do, the yellow on top if they have a question, and the green on top if they understand the assignment and are working well. (L9.3S Used formatively)

Lesson closing

- A few minutes before the end of class, direct the students to put away all their materials. Ask the review questions:
  - Name one way bullying effects the body? (7.1u)
  - Name one effect of bullying on the bully. (7.1u)
  - Name one thing a teen can do if being bullied. (7.3s)

#### **Assessment Idea**

- Formative: Red, Yellow, Green rectangles
- Summative: What to do statements on the templates
- Summative: Rubric

Tell an adult

Try to avoid being alone

Ignore the bully and confidently walk away

Hold the anger because the bully wants you to get angry.

What to do

Take charge of your life! Get involved in activities that make you feel good about yourself.

Talk about the bullying to a trusted adult or friend who can give you support.

Find your true friends and share your feelings about what is happening.

Don't get physical.

Sleep: Trouble sleeping


