Learning Objectives

• I can identify household products that are harmful or poisonous.

Teacher Notes

Lesson Steps: Video Outline K.1m Video

Step 1 Introduction

- Did you know household products are really helpful but can also be really harmful?
- How do you know if something is safe to use on your own?

Step 2 Activity

- Review the list of products as a class and discuss dangers they could have. (more products and slides linked below if interested)
- Activity: Product Hunt
 - o Teacher will place household products (or print pictures of) on desks.
 - Students will move around the room to music.
 - When the music stops students will go to a desk and look at what is on it.
 - The teacher will say, "3 2-1" and students will either hold up a thumbs up (safe to use on my own) or a thumbs down (not safe to use on my own).
 - Have a class discussion as needed.
 - o Repeat allowing students to identify as many of the products as possible.

Step 3 Closure

• If you don't know what a product is or how it should be used, what should you do?

Assessments

- Pre: Questions will introduce topic, engage learners, and access prior knowledge.
- Post: The activity will demonstrate student understanding of material covered during class.
 Teacher will observe student choices to determine level of understanding.
